- Call to Order      The general meeting of the Collins Elementary School PTA was held at Collins Elementary School on Thursday January 26, 2023. The president, Crystal Matheu called the meeting to order at 6:33 PM. The secretary was present.

- Quorum      A quorum was established.
- Minutes      The minutes of the previous general meeting were read. Motion by Elisabeth Spero to approve the minutes as written. Motioned carried.
- Financial Report      The treasurer, Elisabeth Spero, presented the Treasurer Report. Account balance on 7/1/2022 was \$39,658.60. Account balance on 1/26/2023 is \$29,767.10. Total income was \$45,492.51 and total expenses were \$55,384.01. Treasurer's Report was filed.
- Budget Changes      Elisabeth, the Treasurer, went over the current year budget, and listed the budget line items that need to be changed and voted on. This includes deleting the income for February grams, moving \$1,000 each to teacher appreciation, hospitality, teacher subscriptions, library books, and summer contingency. Michelle Speiss motioned to approve the budget changes. Motion carried.
- Fundraising 22/23      Mrs. Sargable would like to use some of the 22/23 budget to paint murals once the new school is complete. This would be in addition to what was already voted on at the previous meeting, which was STEM items and items for Specials. Beve DeMott motioned to approve the budget changes. Motion carried.
- Spirit Wear      No more spirit wear items will be purchased. There are still some items available for purchase, mainly long sleeve shirts and jackets. Mrs. Sargable will mention in the call out that spirit wear is still available.

- Easy Fundraising Amazon Smiles program is ending in February. There is another easy fundraising option through Member Hub. You go into Member Hub and download a widget that will activate give backs automatically. So far this year Collins has earned \$34.67 from Member Hub.
- Boosterthon Boosterthon shirts will cost around \$7,000 and we will need sponsors to cover the cost. The sponsors will be needed before March 1. There are already a few sponsors signed up. Students will run on the primary playground and the Kona Ice truck will be up against the fence.
- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Banquet The committee sold 162 shirts for about a \$1,200 profit. They are beginning to purchase needed items for the banquet. It is recommended that next year to try to sell grade level shirts in the fall semester, if next years committee would like to do this. The banquet is May 25.
- 23/24 Board If you are interested in joining the board next year, please email which position you are interested in. Next year will be a PTSA due to Collins becoming a K-8 school.
